

INDIANA SMOKE FREE COMMUNITY ORDINANCES

Allen County, June 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Avon, September 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free. Outdoor dining is smoke free except for bars.

Bloomington, Jan. 1, 2005, public buildings, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Carmel, March 5, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free.

Columbus, Feb. 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free.

Crown Point, April 1, 2008, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free. Outdoor dining is smoke free except for bars.

Cumberland, Jan. 1, 2008, all public places, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Delaware County*, June 21, 2006, public places and workplaces are smoke free. However, law allows for separate smoking rooms in restaurants.

Elkhart, May 15, 2008, all public places, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Evansville*, Jan. 2, 2007, law only requires that establishments have separate non-smoking areas.

Fort Wayne, June 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces, restaurants, bars, and membership clubs are smoke free.

Franklin, June 3, 2009, all public places, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Goshen*, Sept. 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free. However, law allows for separate smoking rooms in restaurants.

Greencastle, Sept. 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces, restaurants and bars are smoke free.

Greenfield, March 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free.

Greensburg, Nov. 7, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Greenwood, April 22, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Hancock County, March 25, 2009, all public places, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Henry County, Jan. 1, 2011, all public places, workplaces, restaurants, and bowling alleys are smoke free. Social clubs, bars and bingo halls employing minors younger than 18 are smoke free.

Indianapolis, March 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants and bars serving or employing minors younger than 18 are smoke free.

Indianapolis International Airport, January 1, 2008, all grounds are smoke free.

Jeffersonville, June 15, 2006, all public places, workplaces, including restaurants are smoke free.

Kokomo, October 6, 2006, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free.

Lafayette, September 1, 2008, all public places, workplaces, and restaurants are smoke free. Exempts places where only 21 and older are admitted.

Lawrence, July 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Madison, August 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Monroe County, February 1, 2006, public buildings, workplaces, restaurants including outdoor dining areas and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free. Smoking in vehicles is prohibited when children 13 years of age and younger are present.

Morgan County*, Jan. 1, 2005, all public places and workplaces are smoke free. Restaurants may have a separate smoking room.

Plainfield, Feb. 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces, restaurants and bars are smoke free. Membership clubs are smoke free.

Seymour, July 30, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Shelbyville*, Aug. 1, 2006, all public places and workplaces are smoke free. Restaurants may have a separate smoking room.

Speedway, Sept. 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

St. Joseph County*, April 10, 2006, all public places and workplaces are smoke free. Restaurants may have a separate smoking room.

Valparaiso*, April 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free. However, places that are exempt must comply with ventilation requirements.

Vanderburgh County*, Jan. 2, 2007, all public places and workplaces are smoke free. Restaurants and bars may have a separate smoking room.

Vigo County*, July 1, 2007, all public places and workplaces are smoke free. Restaurants may have a separate smoking room.

Westfield, Oct. 14, 2009, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

West Lafayette, July 1, 2007, all public places, workplaces, restaurants and bars are smoke free.

Whitestown, Oct. 1, 2006, all public places, workplaces and restaurants are smoke free.

Zionsville, August 10, 2006, all public places, workplaces, restaurants and bars, and membership clubs are smoke free.

*Has exemptions that do not follow the Surgeon General's recommended guidelines for protecting citizens from exposure to secondhand smoke.
